## Maximize Your Space

A good solution for getting the maximum number of functions for square footage available in your facility is to use moveable walls. With moveable walls, you control how the space is utilized. When you need more space for a big meeting, you pull the walls back. When you need a smaller configuration, you close them up.

There are four basic types of moveable walls:

1. Individual panel operation—These are manually operated single panels that can make turns on an overhead structural support track to carry the weight of the walls.
2. Center hung pair operation—These are manually operated paired panels that travel on a straight run track. The moveable wall consists of panels hinged together in evenly matched pairs. The hinged pair operating is simple to install and operate and is the most utilized product for space management.
3. Center hung continuously hinged manual operation—These are manually operated continuously hinged panels that travel on a straight run track. Operation consists of panels hinged together in a continuous panel train.
4. Center hung continuously hinged electrically operated—These are electrically operated panels that travel on a straight run track. Operation consists of panels hinged together in a continuous panel train and is moved by an electric motor with a drive unit. Electrically operated wall systems are totally automatic with limit switches that shut the motor off when the panels are extended across the opening or stacked in their stored position. This type is best used in a multi-purpose room or gym when a large span is being divided.

Moveable wall systems are a great cost-effective means to maximize your space utilization.
